Phrasal verbs


This is the form. Please can you fill it in?

very common in English, especially in more informal contexts.

They are made up of a verb and a particle or, sometimes, two particles.

The particle often **changes the meaning** of the verb.

I called Jen to see how she was. (call = to telephone) They've called off the meeting. (call off = to cancel)

came across	find something by chance	One particle Non-separable	came across your email when I was clearing my inbox.
get rid of	remove or become free of something that you don't want	Two particles (inseparable)	Let's get rid of these old magazines to make more space.
